## Week 3

### Sunday School

We will miss you each week in Sunday School! Below is an example of something that we would be doing at church, but is something you can do easily at home with minimal supplies.

#### Today's Bible Story

Read John 20:1-18

#### Discussion

Maybe the good news this Easter is that even though parts of the world as we knew it are being undone, these eternal truths are reaffirmed. Like Mary, we are recognized and known, by the One whose life and love renews each of us and all the world. ALLELUIA!

1. What is different about your life within the last month or two? What has remained the same?
2. What are some losses you are mourning?
3. Where do you see new life and love around you?

#### Activity

Normally on Easter Sunday we have a scavenger hunt to tell the Easter story. Below is one way you can learn the story in your home with an egg hunt.

**Step 1:** At the end of this document you will see pictures that you will need to print out. Cut them out and then put them in plastic Easter Eggs. Don't have a printer or Easter Eggs? Write out a description of what is happening in the scene on a piece of paper and hide the paper by itself.

**Step 2:** Who doesn't love candy and chocolate? If you have some at home, put some in extra Easter eggs for your children to eat along the hunt.

**Step 3:** Hide the eggs around the house or in your yard without your children looking.

**Step 4:** Time to hunt! Have your kids collect all the eggs.

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**Step 5:** After they have found all the eggs, open them up and place all the paper pieces in front of you. Now its time to try and organize the pictures that depict the Easter story from beginning to end. Optional: Colour the pictures before they organize them.

**Step 6:** Check out this video to see if you organized them correctly. \*\*Note: The pictures below are not the same ones as in the video, but are the same concept.

## Stained Glass



### What you will need:

| Tempura Paint             | Water          |
| Tape(painters or masking) | Dish Detergent |
| Container                 |                |

### Instructions

1. Choose one small tupperware or container per color paint you are using.
2. Squirt in the paint needed. We started with a tablespoon or so of paint to start with.
3. Add in 1-2 drops of dish soap.
4. Add a quick squirt of water. I just ran the tap water lightly and gave the entire container a quick swipe.
5. Adjust the paint amount or soap/water as needed.
6. Put tape on a front window (so others can enjoy) to create a cross and then make different sections around it. (see picture)
7. When paint is dry, peel off tape.
